Campaign Coach, Groups Ministry

Job Description

Purpose:

To help new group hosts get off to a great start by providing coaching and care.

Description of Duties:

- 1. Growing to be a God First person by making my relationship with Jesus Christ a priority—being in community with Him is the foundation for all community.
- 2. Leading a God First Christian lifestyle—Small Group Leaders watching me will see an obedient servant of Jesus Christ growing in maturity.
- 3. Connect with new hosts on a weekly basis by phone or in person. Emailing and texting are great for follow-up, but not for connecting.
- 4. Answer questions and offer support to a new leader.
- 5. Encourage each Host to attend the host luncheon at the end of the campaign.
- 6. Wrap up the campaign with a team meeting and update with church's groups staff.
- 7. Participate in trainings provided by the church to equip you with this role.

Time Requirements: Serving as a campaign coach is a 10-13 week commitment that will set aside time to touch base with new hosts each week during a church-wide campaign. Typically, 1-2 hours a week is sufficient to carry out the responsibilities in caring for their leaders.

Qualifications:

- Loyalty to the Senior Pastor and the Senior Leaders of the church
- A proven gift of leadership inside and outside of the church
- Committed to the principle of doing life together (demonstrated by the personal life style of living life together in the church)
- Will have availability during weekdays as well as weekends to do this ministry, always maximizing opportunities around services
