

Community Leader, Groups Ministry

Job Description

Purpose:

To ensure everyone at CRCC is connected, cared for and urged to grow by caring for Group Leaders and their members.

Description of Duties:

1. Growing to be a God First person by making my relationship with Jesus Christ a priority—being in community with Him is the foundation for all community.
2. To lead a God First Christian lifestyle—Small Group Leaders watching me will see an obedient servant of Jesus Christ growing in maturity.
3. To provide personalized care based on the needs of each leader and development for each Small Group Leader by making sure they are Connected, Cared For, and Urged to Grow.
4. To assist in the identification, development and confirmation of new Small Group Leaders within the groups in my huddle.
5. To identify and develop my own Community Leader Apprentice who will lead their own huddle someday.
6. To gather with other Community Leaders in a gathering for my own care and coaching needs.
7. To gather my huddle (Small Group Leaders and Co-Leaders) for Small Group Ministry Leadership events twice a year (fall and spring).
8. To gather my huddle (Small Group Leaders and Co-Leaders) for huddle meetings three times a year (Not included with church-wide leadership events).

Time Requirements: Community Leader is available to the group leader by being flexible with their time from week to week. Typically, 1-2 hours a week is sufficient to carry out the responsibilities in caring for their leaders.

Qualifications:

- Loyalty to the Senior Pastor and the Senior Leaders of the church
- Sold out to the mission and vision of CRCC
- A proven gift of leadership inside and outside of the church
- Committed to the principle of doing life together (demonstrated by the personal life style of living life together in the church)
- Will have availability during weekdays as well as weekends to do this ministry, always maximizing opportunities around services
- Basic computer skills (will be trained on toolbox)
